

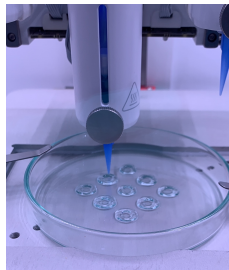
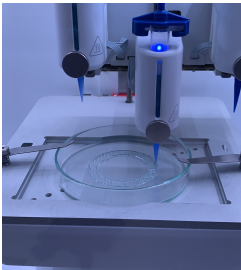
# Midwest Regional 3D Symposium
